



All About Me – Autumn 1
<b>Communication and Language:</b> Shows interest in play with sounds, songs and rhymes.
<b>Personal, Social and Emotional Development:</b> Find ways to calm themselves, through being calmed and comforted by their key person.
<b>Physical Development:</b> Walk, run, jump and climb – and start to use the stairs independently.
<b>Literacy:</b> Enjoy songs and rhymes, tuning in and paying attention, joining in with some words and actions.
<b>Mathematics:</b> Climb and squeeze themselves into different types of spaces.
<b>Understanding the World:</b> Repeat actions that have an effect.
<b>Expressive Art and Design:</b> Enjoy and take part in action songs, such as 'Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star'.

Our continuous provision allows children to explore space, learn to assess risks, to climb, go over and under items. Through den building, boxes, tunnels and tents children will learn to squeeze in spaces and assess to see if there is space for them.

A new song is learnt fortnightly to create a repertoire of songs which the children can sing and request.

Rhymes are used to supplement teaching and are a key part of our phase 1 phonics teaching.

Singing is a fundamental part of our provision and is used to teach skills from all areas. It is build into our daily routine and schedule and songs will be learnt throughout the year.

During the term our continuous provision is enhanced weekly with new items to keep children curious and exploring cause and effect.
