<u>Science</u>

The children will be finding out about animals including humans, this is a vast subject and will be continued during the spring term. This term we will begin by exploring living things and how we know if something is living.

We will be learning the names for parts of a human body and then the senses we have. Using some different experiences for the children to consider our sense of taste, smell, sight, hearing and touch with a range of hands-on activities to fully engage learning.

We will also be using data to create a table of information and then complete a range of activities to show understanding of how to read and use data.

Phonics and Reading

This half term we continue our phonics journey with Little Wandle. The children will be moving onto the Phase 5 sounds and tricky words. Our reading lessons continue with three weekly sessions with the focus of decoding, prosody and comprehension. You can help your child at home by hearing your child read their 'show off' book and going over the phonics sheet, which is sent home on a Thursday.
