We will be exploring the outside areas at school as well as completing a range of practical activities in class linked to the identification of plants and trees that are commonly grown in the wild and in garden in the United Kingdom.

In addition, we will have our third seasons day, looking at the signs of spring around the school grounds.

Phonics and Reading

Our reading lessons continue with three weekly sessions with the focus of decoding, prosody and comprehension. You can help your child at home by hearing your child read their 'show off' book and going over the phonics sheet, which is sent home on a Thursday.
