Maths

In maths we will be starting to look at fractions, finding parts of whole, place value within 100 and telling the time.

You can help your child by finding parts of whole, counting backwards and forwards and looking at clocks.

Science

This term we will be learning about materials. The children will explore a range of materials that we have around us, think about their uses, how to identify different materials (wood, plastic, metal, fabric) based on their properties (soft, hard, smooth, bumpy, rough, absorbent, waterproof) and begin to use materials for our own experiments to determine the best use of them.

In addition, we will have our final seasons day, looking at the signs of summer around the school grounds.

We will be focusing on these key aspects of the National Curriculum but when using Curious Quest, we are also using high quality vocabulary.

Phonics and Reading

This half term we continue our phonics journey with Little Wandle. The children will be recapping the Phase 5 sounds learnt so far as well as learning new sounds and tricky words. Our reading lessons continue with three weekly sessions with the focus of decoding, prosody and comprehension. *You can help your child at home by hearing your child read their 'show off' book and going over the phonics sheet, which is sent home on a Thursday.*

Computing

Programming animations:

Learners will explore the way a project looks by investigating sprite and backgrounds in Scratch Junior. They will use programming blocks to use, modify, and create programs. Learners will also be introduced to the early stages of program design through the introduction of algorithms.
